There are no doubt many other inmates at Tihar who are determined to pursue higher studies upon release.

Fortunately for them, the prison administration believes in education through education. To cater to the educational needs of prisoners, it runs both formal and non-formal education, and more importantly, self-education. "We have a knowledge club education club weekly and it is compulsory for inmates to attend," said Sudhakar, an officer, Tihar prison. Student enrolment: Such a success of IGNOU and NCERT, an estimated 10,000 inmates are enrolled at Tihar, and 1,000 at 125 prisons restricted to one enrolled at present. Also, enrolment in the National Open School (NOS) in the year 2006 was 150 and 27 for class I and II respectively. Various national courses are also provided in collaboration with the directors of technical education, government of Delhi.

Around 200 inmates are presently enrolled with the academic and vocational courses for the year 2006-08. Besides, 11 inmates have enrolled for computer-aided courses imparted by Pusa Institute, under 14 of them are enrolled for a diploma in computer application from Institute Foundation.
