

Kiran Bedi to be honoured with Krantiveer award

HONOURED WITH various prestigious national and international awards, India's first woman IPS officer Kiran Bedi will be conferred with the National Krantiveer Award for 2007.

The award — instituted in the memory of late freedom fighter Ramchandra Raghuvanshi 'Kakaji' in 1988 — would be bestowed on

Bedi at a function to be organised in Ujjain on April 4.

Social activist Omprakash Khatri said the function is organised on the banks of river Narmada every year.
